Science

Italian

We completed our learning about 'Sending and Receiving' this week. We were working in pairs, to safely send and receive a 'nectar' tennis ball whilst moving as buzzy bees. We then used a tennis racket to pass a ball in fours.

Religious Education

This week we completed our Religious Education topic about 'To the Ends of the Earth.' We first learned about the mission of the Church and how this links to the same mission of Jesus Christ, as well as our own school mission statement. We then learned about how other Christians around the world celebrate Pentecost. We looked at how Mass is celebrated in the Pantheon in Rome, where red rose petals fall from the domed roof.

Maths

We have mainly been completing our Maths assessments to show all of our learning from this half term. We were practising our number and place value, our skills at adding and subtracting and our understanding of measurement. We have made a lot of progress since September!

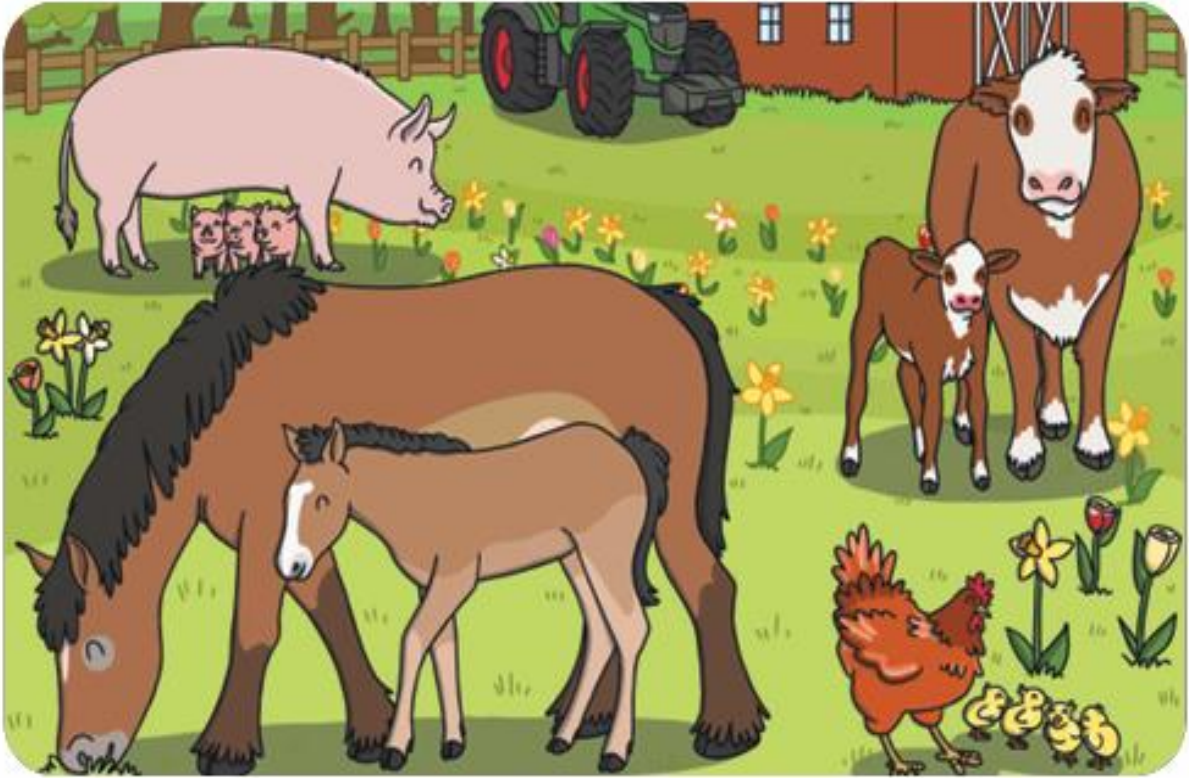
Design and Technology

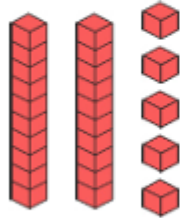

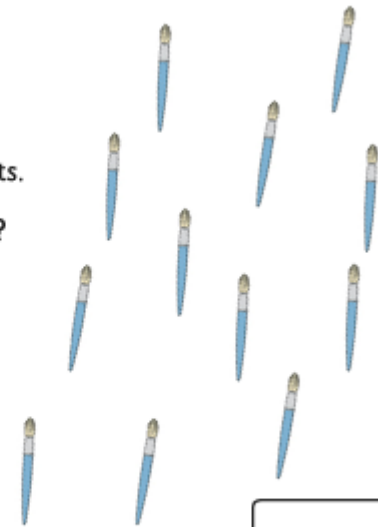
