

English

This week, we concluded our topic on poetry. We written our own poem about a colour of our choice. We thought about what an adjective is and added this into our poem to describe each object. We also wrote a list of adjectives, using a comma to separate two adjectives. We edited our poem and wrote it so neatly.

Science

We completed our topic by knowing that God loves us. We listened to a Gospel story and thought about why Jesus told his disciples to let the little children come to him.

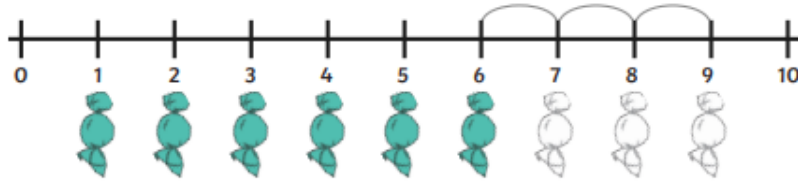

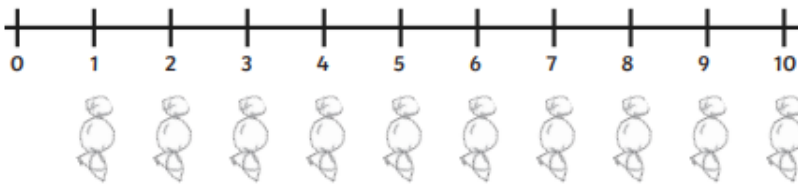
Number Line Subtraction

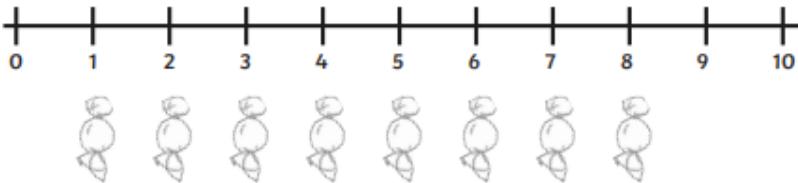

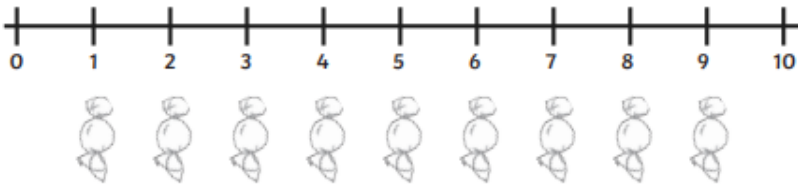

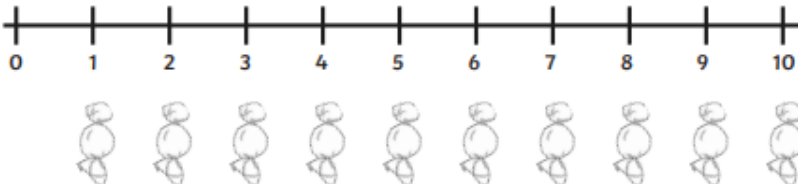
