

English

This week, we continued our topic on poetry. We thought about objects that we can think of that the colour red. We then thought of adjectives to describe these coloured objects. This helped us to write our own list poem about the colour 'red'. We edited our poem, checking for finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Science

This week, we continued our topic 'Seasonal Changes.' We were observing and describing the weather, saying what we thought would happen to the weather based on our observations and why. We also gathered data about the weather.

PE

We have continued our topic of Target Games this week in P.E. We extended our underarm throwing accuracy: not only using a beanbag, but also learning to throw with a quoit in a Frisbee style and a shuttlecock with an overarm throw. We then used a quoit in groups of four and had a relay race.

Italian

Today, we revised singing two songs to ten and then started to recognise the numbers in words. We also started to learn how to sing Tanti Auguri (Happy Birthday).

Computing

This week we continued our Computing Systems and Networks topic by improving our use of a computer keyboard. We are able to say what a keyboard is for, we practised typing our name on a computer and how to save our work to a file.

RE

This week we continued our Religious Education topic of 'Creation and Covenant.' We wrote a list poem linked with English about how a community in Colombia cares for the Amazon rainforest. We also thought about how prayer is a way to draw closer to God. In groups we created our own prayer area, choosing prompts, images and artefacts to then pray together.

Maths

We have reviewed all of our learning so far this half term, including adding and part-whole models. We have also been looking at how we can regroup a number to make 5 first if we are trying to add two numbers that will total more than five. This is known as regrouping.

Music

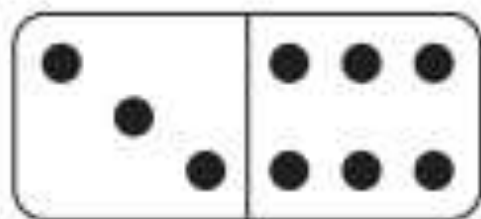
This week in Music, we were developing our understanding of duration of pulse and beats. We explored how beats can have different lengths and performed the pulses given using a variety of instruments.

Design and Technology

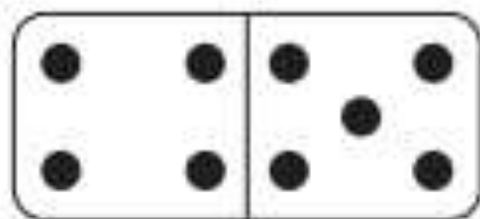
This week in our Dips and Dippers topic, we designed our own dip, thinking about the 'Eatwell Plate' and what food groups would be in the dip that we were designing.
