Daily timetable

- Children will be taught Maths and English in the morning as well as Guided Reading.
- We will also be carrying out Maths Fluency sessions at the beginning of each maths lesson which focuses on arithmetic and reasoning skills.
- ► The children will carry out foundation subjects in the afternoon, such as, Geography, Art, Music, Science and History.
- RE takes place for two and a half hours every week. This includes half and hour of RSE.
- PSHE and Wellbeing lessons and assemblies will also be taking place over each half term.

P.E

- P.E takes place twice a week on Monday and Friday afternoon.
- Children need to come to school in their PE kits unless there is a need for children to me wearing school uniform (mass/photos)
 - On these occasions, the children will be given time to change before the lesson and will bring their PE kits home.

Homework Expectations Maths

Homework will be set each Friday and will link the class work for that week.

Times Tables Rock Stars

- Children will be encouraged to use Times Table Rock Stars to improve the fluency of their times tables.
- There will be certificates awarded in celebration assembly for children whose Rock Star progresses. There are also whole class awards given.
- ▶ The importance of knowing times tables fluently is so important as it underpins so much of the UKS2 curriculum.

Homework Expectations Prayer book

- Every year group has a prayer book on their RE table.
- This is an important book for our class to write and reflect.
- Every day, a different child will be asked to take home the class prayer book. The expectation is that they will write their own prayer and decorate it and then share it with the rest of the class.
- ▶ There is an example in the front and a list of the different types of prayer that the children can write.
- It is a fantastic opportunity for the children to share their creativity and reflections with the class and God.
