This week in English, we finished writing our own graphic novels inspired by Arthur and the Golden Rope. We also learnt about conjunctions, focusing on how to use them accurately to link our ideas and improve our sentences.

Science

This week in science, we explored whether gases have a mass. To test this, we carried out an experiment using fizzy drinks. We observed what happened as the gas escaped and used our results to help us understand that gases do have weight.

Maths

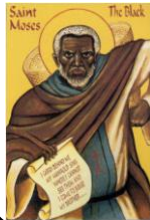
