In English this week the children have been learning about parenthesis and re-visiting prepositions. They have designed and labelled the key features of their creature and have begun planning their Non Chronological Report.

Science

In Science this week, the children have been learning about pre-natal growth. They have learnt about how an embryo becomes a foetus and at which stage. We looked at different fruits to compare the size of growth at key stages in development.
