

English

In English this week the children have completed their Non-Chronological Report and created a Class Anthology. The children have now begun their new writing project a narrative based on the book Cloud Tea Monkeys. The children have enjoyed listening to the story and have been examining how the author has used language and the moral choices made.

Science

In science this week, the children have been learning about the growth of animals and humans focusing upon late adulthood and the changes that ensue.

Computing

In computing the children have been learning about how the role of computer systems help manage tasks and the input of humans. The children have also learnt about keeping their personal data safe online.

RE

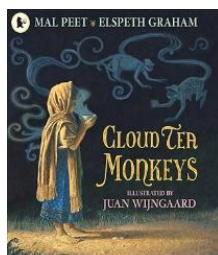
