

English

We explored the features of speeches and letters, focusing on organisational devices and how to structure our writing effectively. We learnt how to create a strong paragraph using the PEPSS format, helping us organise our points clearly with evidence, persuasive language and explanations.

Science

We explored the different types of teeth found in the human mouth and learnt about their special jobs in the digestive system. We identified incisors, canines, premolars and molars, discussing how each type of tooth helps us bite, tear and chew food.

D&T

We started our new topic on battery-operated lights. We began by researching different types of lights and electrical products, exploring how they are designed and what makes them effective.

RSE/PSHE

We explored how to deal with falling out with friends. We discussed the importance of communication, listening to others' feelings and finding positive ways to solve disagreements calmly and respectfully.

PE

We focused on short-distance work in golf, practising our control, accuracy and putting skills. We also continued developing our understanding of positions in netball, learning the roles and responsibilities of different players and how teamwork and movement are important during a game.

Computing

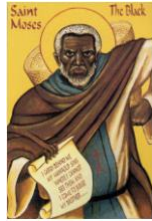
