

## English

This week in English, we began writing the first drafts of our travel leaflets for our dream locations. We practised using key persuasive skills, including the power of three and rhetorical questions, to make our writing more engaging and convincing.

## Science

This week in science, we completed a series of mini experiments to investigate whether sound travels best through solids, liquids, or gases. We found that sound travels fastest through solids, but it was clearest through gases (air).

## D&T

We began creating design ideas for our juggling balls and explained our choices, thinking carefully about materials, colours, and how the designs would work in practice.

## RSE/PSHE

This week in RSE, we explored the sacraments by looking at the story of why Jesus performed a miracle and saved Jairus' daughter, helping us understand God's love, healing, and care for others.

## PE

In football we practised dribbling skills such as using the inside and outside of the foot to control the ball and turn away from opponents, and we also worked on passing to teammates to keep possession and move the ball around.

## Computing

We explored how to plot data online using Excel and created bar charts to represent information clearly and visually.

## Maths


