#### Curriculum

- OChildren will be undertaking Maths, Writing and Guided Reading lessons in the morning.
- OIn the afternoon children will carry out RE and foundation subjects such as Science, History and Computing.
- ORE takes place for 2 and a half hours each week. One of these sessions will be RSE.
- OArt or DT will be taught weekly.



### Expectations

• All children have a responsibility to live out our Mission Statement:

'We come to school to live and learn happily together by loving ourselves and each other as Jesus teaches us'

- Children are expected to follow our school rules as well as class rules. Class rules have been created with the help of the children.
- Children are also expected to follow the school's Golden Rule:

'Treat others as you wish to be treated'.

 Children should be dressed smartly in school uniform: No trainers and only a small bow in the hair. No big earrings, just small studs.



## MTC Test (Multiplication Tables Check).

This is a Government made test to check and determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help your child's school to identify if your child may need additional support.

It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.

What can you do to help?



#### Homework

- OHomework is set on a Friday via Atom Learning and should be completed by the following Friday on Atom Learning. We will be checking homework in class on Wednesday's together. Each week Spellings, Maths and English tasks will be set (sometimes an additional piece of foundation subject homework).
- OTimes Table Rock Stars should be practised three times a week for 5 minutes. Mrs Baldwin will be running a weekly competition. The children are able to win a certificate which will be presented in Celebration Assembly. Additionally, we check this and update our board.
- OThe children should read at home daily and the home-school book should be signed. At least one book should be handed in once a week, but more can be completed.

#### PE

P.E. takes place twice a week on a Thursday and Friday. Children to come in with their PE kits on unless the office have you informed you otherwise (Mass, etc.).



# Snacks, water and lunch

- A healthy snack can be brought for break times.
- Children should bring drinking bottles with a sport spout to school with them each day.
- Children are eating their lunch in the dining hall. Packed lunches are eating outside when the weather is nice. If they choose to bring a Packed Lunch it should be nutritious.
