We began developing our narrative writing skills by exploring the features of an action-adventure story. We analysed examples of exciting narratives and identified techniques authors use to engage the reader, such as descriptive settings, ambitious vocabulary, suspense, dialogue and action-packed scenes.

Science

We learnt about Garrett Morgan, an inventor whose ideas helped make people's lives safer. We explored his inventions, including the early traffic signal and the safety hood, and discussed how his creativity and problem-solving skills have had a lasting impact on the world.

In Spellings, next week's topic will be going over Year 3 Statutory Words they spelt incorrectly.

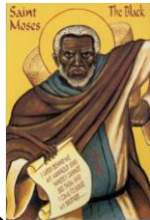
