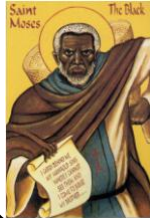
We explored fractions using measurements. We learned how to find fractions of lengths, mass, and capacity, and used equipment to help solve problems and understand how fractions are used in real life.
