This week in maths, we began our new topic of place value. We explored four-digit numbers by learning how to compare and order them, as well as breaking them down into their parts and whole numbers.

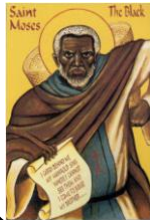
Music
