

### English

We wrote the first drafts of our group haikus, working together to create a renga. We carefully thought about imagery and structure to link our poems.

In SPaG, we focused on using apostrophes correctly, including for possession and contractions.

### Science

We began our new topic of animals including humans by exploring the start of the digestive system. We focused on the mouth, learning about the roles of the teeth, saliva and tongue in breaking down food and preparing it for digestion.

### Art

We created maquettes inspired by the Terracotta Army. Using cardboard, we designed and built our own small-scale sculptures, focusing on shape, structure and detail to bring our figures to life.

### RSE/PSHE

In PSHE, we explored the themes of love and loss. We discussed different types of relationships, how people show care for one another, and how to understand and manage feelings when experiencing loss or change.

### PE

We developed our putting accuracy in golf, focusing on control and precision. In netball, we began exploring different positions, learning the roles and responsibilities of each player on the court.

### Computing

We finished editing, cropping and formatting images using Microsoft Word. We learned how to place one image in the foreground over a background, developing our skills in layering and presentation.

### Maths

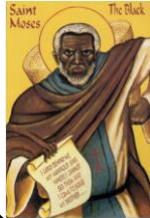
We started our new topic of time. We learned how to convert between 12-hour and 24-hour time and began exploring duration, working out how long events last by finding the difference between start and end times.

### History
