

English

We started our new topic on persuasive writing by exploring the powerful speeches of Malala Yousafzai and Greta Thunberg. We looked at the important work they have done and how they use language to inspire and influence others.

Science

We completed an experiment to investigate tooth decay by placing eggs in different liquids. As eggshells are similar to the enamel on our teeth, we used them to observe how substances like drinks can affect tooth health over time.

Art

We were inspired by Vivienne Westwood to create our own punk and avant-garde outfits. We explored her bold and rebellious style, using imaginative designs, unusual shapes, and creative details.

RSE/PSHE

We explored the theme of memories. We discussed how memories can be both happy and sad, and how they help shape who we are.

PE

We were lucky to have a coach from Tottenham Hotspur come in to teach us football, where we developed our skills in control, passing, and teamwork. In addition, our cricket coach worked with us to build our understanding of key cricket skills.

Computing

We developed our image editing skills by using a range of tools. We explored how to apply shadow effects, adjust brightness and contrast, and use recolour to change the look of images. We also practised cropping and rotating pictures.

Maths

We developed our understanding of time by solving problems involving missing start and end times, using our knowledge of duration to work things out step by step. We also explored how to convert between hours, minutes and seconds.

Music

We explored Minimalist music by composing and performing our own pieces. We focused on using a single cell (a short repeated pattern) and developed it through repetition.
