Science

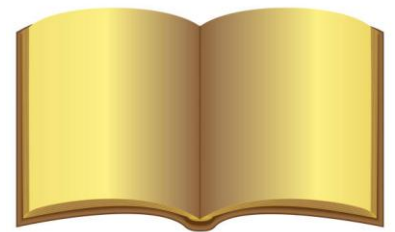
