

## English

This week in English the children completed their poems and had the opportunity to perform them to Year 4. They have now begun their next project a piece of narrative writing, based on the book: The Water Tower.

## Art homework

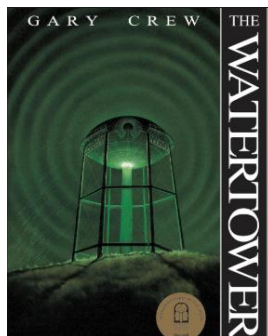
