History

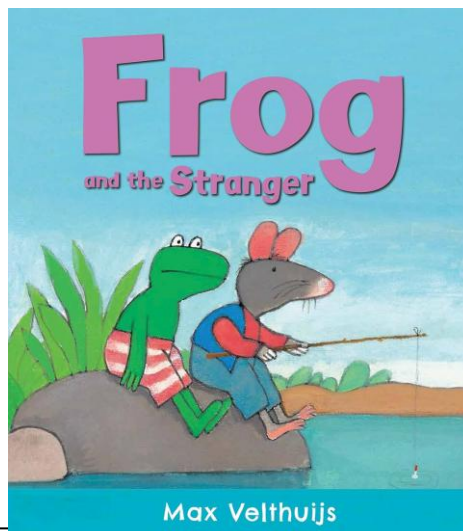
We learnt about Viking Longboats and created our own.

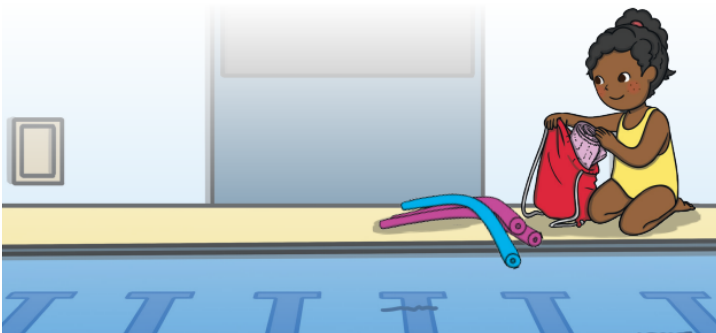

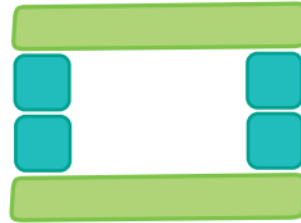
