Mathematics

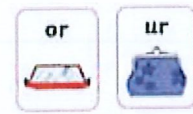
We have been learning about time. We have been able to identify O'clock on a clock face.

We have continued to develop our hopping, running and skipping skills. We even took it in turns to show each other new ways of moving!

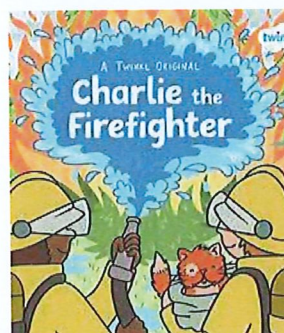
Expressive Arts and Design

Homemade Costume Ideas

Alice

- Blue dress (can even be school summer dress)
- White apron (or make one from an old pillowcase)
- Black headband
- White tights
- Black school shoes
- Safety-pin a paper label saying "DRINK ME"
- Carry a small toy rabbit
- Print and pin a playing card to the apron

Mad Hatter

- Any bright or mismatched clothes
- A homemade top hat (cardboard + tape)
- Paper sign saying "10/6" for the hat
- Face paint (optional for rosy cheeks)

Easy DIY hat idea:

- Use a cereal box to make a tall hat
- Cover in coloured paper or paint
- Tape on the "10/6" card

Queen of Hearts

- Red dress or red top + skirt
- Cut-out hearts stuck on with tape or glue
- Paper crown (yellow card + jewels drawn on)
- A playing card to carry

Playing Card

- Large cardboard sheet
- Paint or markers
- String to hang over shoulders

Cut arm holes and draw:

- Queen of Hearts
- Ace of Spades
- Any card you like!

White Rabbit

- White or light clothes
- Homemade bunny ears (paper + headband)
- Draw-on whiskers
- Cardboard pocket watch

Add a little sign saying "I'm late!"

Cheshire Cat

- Striped clothes (pink/purple if possible)
- DIY tail (stuffed sock pinned safely)
- Cat ears (paper or felt)
- Big painted grin with face paint
