Expressive Arts and Design

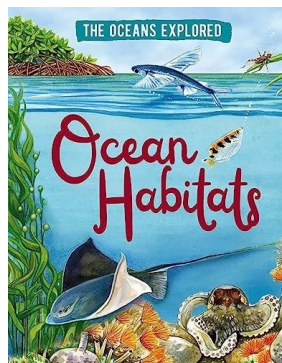
This week, we have made cards to celebrate our Dads. We have used our drawing skills to create a unique portrait. We have also used our phonic knowledge to write a special message in the card.

Parent Information

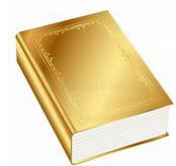
