Personal Social Emotional Development

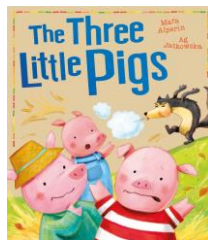
We have discussed how we are all different and how we should all be treated equally.

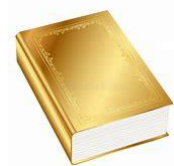
We have focused on improving the time it takes us to complete the Daily Mile.
