We have discussed the meaning of new vocabulary such as *expedition* and *equipment*.

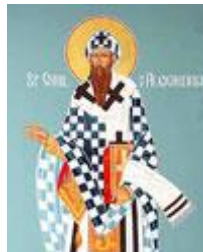

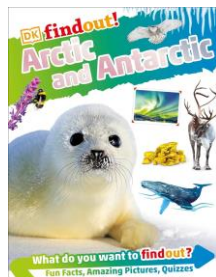
We have focused on working in a team. We followed instructions and worked together to complete a variety of group activities.

Expressive Arts and Design

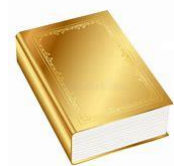
We have become Arctic Explorers! This week, we have designed our own clothes and equipment to take on an expedition of the Frozen Kingdom.
