Dear Year 5 Parents,

Next year, both Year 6 classes from St. Cross and St. Augustine's will be attending their PGL Residential Programme together. This will give our children the opportunity to meet each other, away from a school environment, and to form new friendships before their transition onto secondary education.

We have some date options listed below, which vary the price of our stay. The prices listed do not include transport but take into account accommodation, food, bedding and all activities :-

- Monday 3rd November until Friday 7th November 2025 - £397.00
- Monday 3rd November until Wednesday 5th November 2025 - £203.00
- Monday 1st June to Friday 5th June 2026 - £541.00
- Monday 1st June to Wednesday 3rd June - £307.00

After viewing the venue, please complete the Parent Questionnaire link by Monday 2nd June 2025

If your child is definitely not attending, I ask that you select this option now so that we have a clearer indication of numbers attending when costing the transport into the above amounts.

Once we know how many children are attending, we will issue a further letter and set up a payment schedule.

A non-refundable deposit will then be required to secure your child's place, followed by monthly instalments (due by the last day of each month) for the remainder of the monies due. Monthly payments must be made once you have committed to this trip as we also have to pay our trip providers in instalments too.
