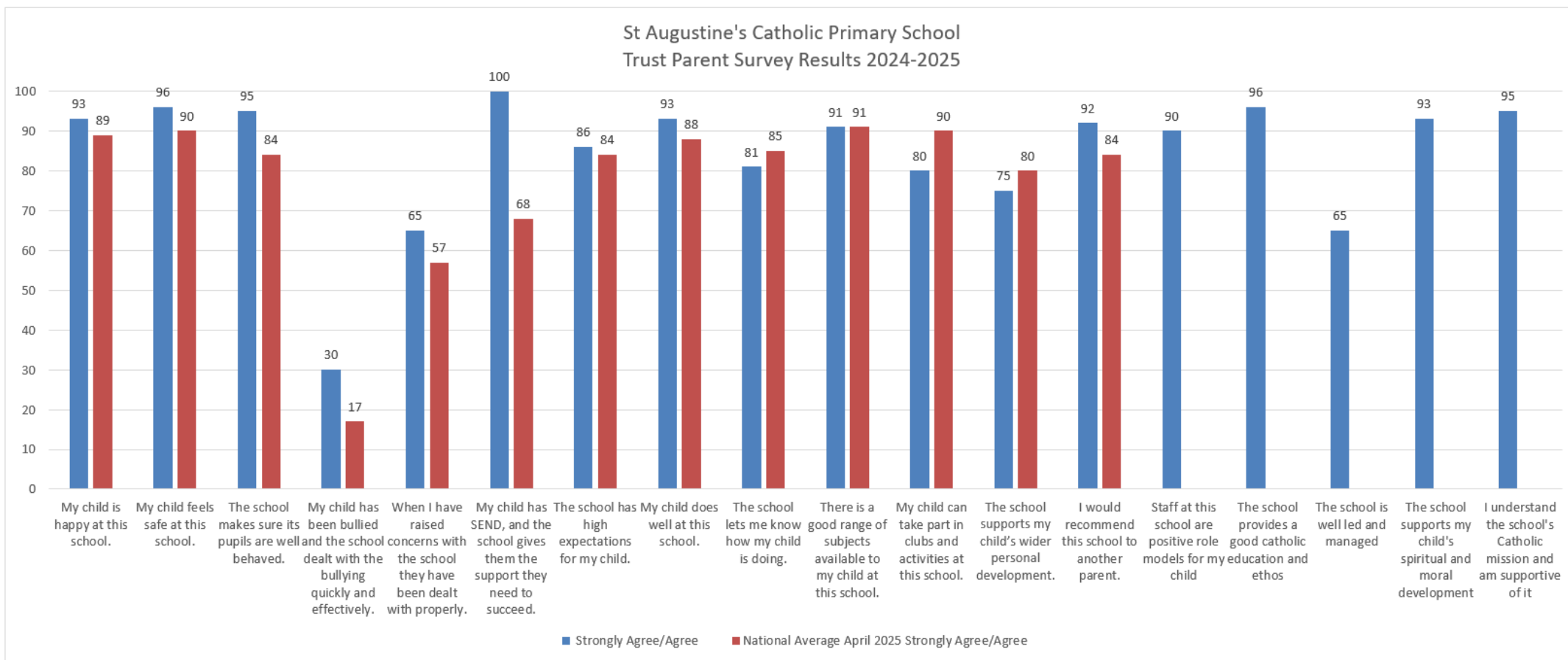
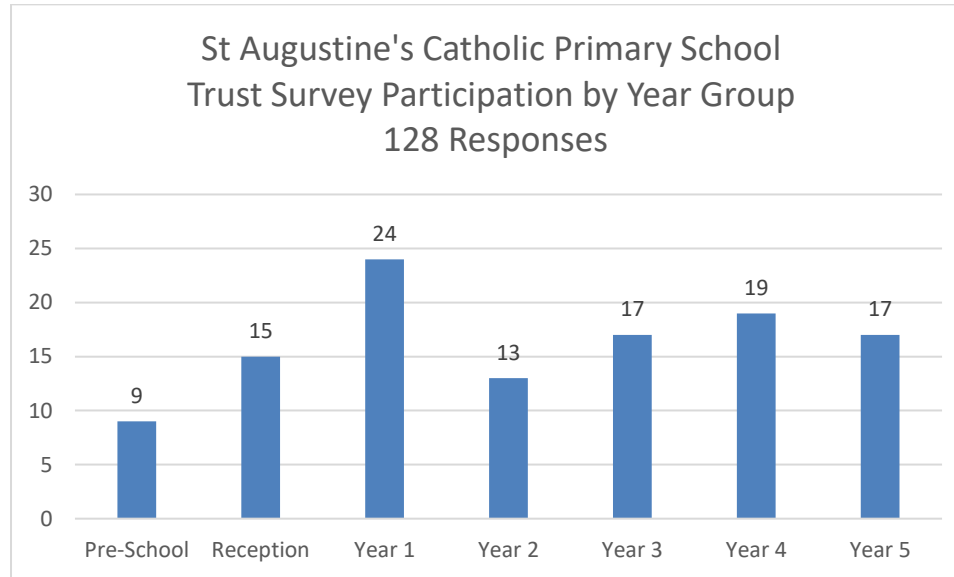




St Augustine's Catholic Primary School Trust Parent Survey Results 2024-25
