Dear Year 1 Parents,

As informed at the Meet the Teacher evening, Year One's school trip this year will be to The Hive Centre at Waltham Forest on Tuesday 24th March 2022. Children should arrive for school at the normal time, in their full school uniform. After morning registration, Year One will be departing by coach at 8.55am and should arrive back at school at 3pm therefore, collection will be at the end of the normal school day (3.10pm). In case of delays, the school office will keep parents updated.

Please ensure your child has a packed lunch in a plastic bag, labelled with their name, and a drink in a disposable bottle or carton. **No fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate please. No nuts or nut products are allowed due to allergies.** Dependant on the weather, we may advise you to provide your child with a waterproof coat and wellington boots, but this will be notified the week before the trip.

The children will be participating in two exciting sessions during the day: Meet the Animals in the morning and then going on a Plant Sensory Trail in the afternoon. Both of these sessions link with their spring 1 Science topic of 'Animals including humans' and spring 2 Science topic of 'Plants.'

Children will not need any spending money, as we will not be visiting a gift shop.

The cost of this trip will be £26.55 per child and is based on all children attending the trip. Please make your payments and provide consent through the School Gateway system. All payments should be made no later than Friday 13th March 2026.
