Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 5 & 6 Netball A and B Tournament

Your child has been selected to represent our school in a netball tournament taking place on **Thursday 19th March 2026**. The tournament is taking place at **Broxbourne Secondary School**. We will be **arriving at 9am** to register and the tournament will begin at 9.15am. **It will finish at approximately 11.45am.**

We will require parents to transport their own child or to arrange for someone else to transport their child to the tournament. Mrs Faulkner will be at Broxbourne Secondary school by the sports centre from 8.30am in case of siblings, in case you may prefer to take your child to the netball tournament first.

All parents will be required to collect their child from Broxbourne Secondary School at the end of the tournament which will be approximately 11.45am and return them to school. Please be aware however that the matches could run slightly under or over the time stated. If the tournament ends early then Mrs Faulkner will wait with your child until they are collected. Please be aware that if we do not progress to the finals, we would still appreciate our children to show good sportsmanship and stay to watch and support the teams who do make it through.

We have been advised by Broxbourne Secondary School that as the tournament is taking place during the school day, spectators will not be allowed. School staff and Mrs Faulkner will be there to support and look after both of the netball teams.

Mrs Faulkner will continue to give the children weekly netball training sessions in preparation for the tournament. The children will be given our school netball team kit to wear for the tournament (tops and skorts for girls and tops and shorts for boys). Please wash and return the netball kit as soon after the netball tournament as possible to avoid it being lost; parents will be asked to pay for any missing netball kit so it may be replaced.

If you are not willing to give permission for your child to attend, please inform the school office by Monday 9th February 2026 so another child can be selected in replacement. We will otherwise assume permission has been given for your child to attend.
