Dear Year 4 Parents,

We are pleased to inform you that Year 4 will be going on an educational visit to **Celtic Harmony Camp on Tuesday 21st April**. Children should arrive to school at normal time in their full school uniform. After morning registration they will depart by coach at 9.00am and will arrive back to school before the end of the school day.

This visit links directly to our History topic on the Romans, where the children have been learning about Boudicca and Celtic life during the Roman invasion of Britain. The trip will give the children a valuable opportunity to deepen their understanding of how Celtic people lived, worked and traded during this period, bringing their classroom learning to life.

Please ensure your child has a packed lunch in a plastic bag, labelled with their name, and a drink in a disposable bottle or carton. **No fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate please. No nuts or nut products are allowed due to allergies.** Dependant on the weather, we may advise you to provide your child with a waterproof coat and wellington boots.

The cost of this trip will be £37.45 per child and is based on all children attending the trip. Please make your payments and provide consent through Arbor. All payments should be made no later than Friday 10th April 2026. Children may bring money to spend in the gift shop.
