Dear Year 5 Parents,

One of Year 5's school trips this year will be to The Henry Moore Studios & Gardens at Much Hadham on Thursday 23rd April 2026. Children should arrive for school at the normal time, in their full school uniform. After morning registration, Year 5 will be departing by coach at 8.55am prompt and should arrive back at school at 2pm therefore, collection will be at the end of the normal school day (3.10pm). In case of delays, the school office will keep parents updated.

Please ensure your child has a packed lunch in a plastic bag, labelled with their name, and a drink in a disposable bottle or carton. **No fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate please. No nuts or nut products are allowed due to allergies.** Dependant on the weather, we may advise you to provide your child with a waterproof coat and wellington boots, but this will be notified the week before the trip.

The children will be participating in a tour of the grounds and studios and will then have the opportunity to sketch the grounds and the sculptures. This is an opportunity to learn about the artist Henry Moore and develop their observational and drawing skills supporting the art curriculum. There is a small gift shop we recommend bringing no more than £5.00 (this is optional).

The cost of this trip will be £10.67 per child (this does not include spending money) and is based on all children attending the trip. Please make your payments and provide consent through Arbor. All payments should be made no later than Friday 10th April 2026.
